Coaches and parents,

Thank you for your patience. As we continue to await guidance from the state on game play, we have been told practices can proceed under the following conditions. Please note these are all in accordance with state directives for outdoor venues. Scheduled practices will begin on Saturday, May 16. Coaches will be provided with a practice schedule by May 13th.

1. Players and coaches must remain at least 12 feet away from any spectators.
2. No congregating in dugouts or batting cages.
3. Anyone over age 10 in the park MUST wear a face covering of the mouth and nose - this does not include coaches and players.
4. **NO USE OF THE BLEACHERS.** Parents/guardians need to bring their own seating, or they may also stay in their vehicles.
5. Please use designated entrance/exit only. Each age group coaches will be advised of those points of entry/exit for their field assignment. Hand sanitizer will be available at each entry point.
6. **NO SCRIMMAGE GAMES ALLOWED BETWEEN TEAMS.**
7. Please observe 6 ft distancing among individuals observing, arriving, or leaving. Family groups may be in closer proximity.
8. Coaches will minimize close contact between players.
9. Please limit use of restrooms as much as possible.

ANY VIOLATION OF THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN OUR FACILITY BEING CLOSED BY THE STATE.

We still anticipate a June 1 start of games, however that is still subject to the ban on games being lifted by the State of Arkansas. A season schedule will be released once final guidance from the state is provided to us.
