#### **Article X Sec H Rule 6 Super Pee Wee League**

6. An adult representative of the batting team will feed the balls into the pitching machine. The adult representative will not be allowed the use of a fielding glove.

#### **Proposed Rule Change:**

6. An adult representative of the batting team will feed the balls into the pitching machine. The adult representative will not be allowed the use of a fielding glove. The adult operating the pitching machine will not communicate any instructions, either verbally or physically, to the batter or any runner at any time while he or she is on the field in the capacity of pitching machine operator. Violation of this rule will be penalized as follows: First violation: Warning. Second Violation: Removed to the dugout for the duration of the game.
